In 2011:

1. 26 kids participated in the Children's Hike & Prayer.
2. 3879 kids attended 48 children programs.
3. 342 kids came to 19 Children's club (program with slum & street kids).
4. 410 kids prayed during the World Wide Prayer Day for Children on June 5.
